### Qualifying Childcare offered by schools

- invoiced separately to compulsory education fees
- taking place after school hours
- are not a part of the National Curriculum
- taking place on the premises that form part of the school's annual inspection.

If you don't have regular childcare costs you can save up your vouchers throughout the year and use them when you need them most! This can be especially handy for activities and clubs during school holidays.
