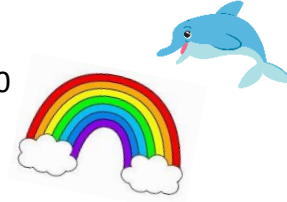

It is lovely to be welcoming children back to ISP in the Key Worker/Vulnerable room and this week, we have four pupils in Year 6! I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that if you are sending your children to school, following the government guidelines on social distancing when out of school is absolutely paramount for the safety of other pupils and my staff.

Following the recent review on provision at ISP, myself and the Chair of Governors, Jennifer Whittam, have been discussing this further over the weekend to see if we can find a solution to our difficulties and invite more year groups back to ISP sooner. The next formal review date is Wednesday 24th June however if you have a child in Year 1, Reception or Nursery then you will receive a survey to complete via ParentMail this week. If you have a child in another year group which has not been mentioned, we absolutely do not want you and your child/ren to feel as though you have been forgotten and it is our intention to arrange a timetable to allow these year groups back at least once or twice before the school year ends.
