Food

- All meals, except for lunch on the first day and dinner on the return journey, are included in the price.
- You will need to supply a packed lunch for the first day.
- On days 2 and 3 our breakfast will be served in the hostel.
- A packed lunch is provided on Thursday and Friday so your child will require a lunch box/bag.
- Our evening meal on day 1 and day 2 will be at the hostel.
- On the return journey, our evening meal stop will be at either Norton Cairns or Stafford Services – please put money in an envelope for this so it doesn't get spent.

Travel

- If your child suffers from travel sickness and requires medication this should have been stated on your consent form.
- On the outward journey we shall make a couple of stops en route.
- Please make sure you pack sufficient food for the journey.
- Your child may wish to bring games, books etc. to amuse themselves during the journey. If they choose to bring an electrical item such as an i-pad, they do so at their own risk.

Clothing

- The children should bring adequate clothing for three days, including changes for varying weather.
- They should bring comfortable footwear for walking.

- A waterproof coat is essential along with a small rucksack to carry packed lunches and rainwear.
- Children will need a towel.

Spending Money

Personal Items

- Children are responsible for their own personal items.
- It would help if items such as cameras were named.
- Whilst Paul does not recommend phones, I am more than happy for you to send your child with a mobile phone so they can contact you in the morning and evening. Mobile phones will be best left at the hostel during the day.

Departure

- Please arrive at school by 5am in order for us to load the coach for a prompt 5.20am departure.
- Please ensure that all baggage is labelled with your child's name.
- It is the responsibility of each parent to ensure that their child's luggage is handed to the coach driver and loaded onto the coach.
