Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you safe and well.

Myself and governors have been exploring ways in which we can invite more year groups back to ISP sooner. At the moment, we are incredibly limited with our teaching staff and although we have 100% trust in the ability of all our Support Staff, we did not want them to take this on alone. We have therefore devised the following plans to share with you

## Reception and Year 1

### Plan A

Dependent on numbers, we would create a Reception/Year 1 bubble. Mrs. Britton and Miss Sanderson would lead this bubble under the supervision of Mrs. Kidson who will be providing work materials for learning time and will also Zoom in daily to take a lesson. Mrs. Britton is level 3 qualified and has valuable experience working in schools and nurseries where she is experienced in covering whole classes. Both Mrs. Britton and Miss Sanderson will be familiar adults to the children.

- The base for this bubble would be Dolphin Class, once prepared and set up.
- Provision would be a Tuesday and Thursday every week with a drop off slot of 9:05-9:15am and a collection slot of 3:00-3:10pm.
- The timetable would be the same as the timetable for the vulnerable/key worker bubble.
- Your child cannot mix between two bubbles during the week. For example, if they attended the vulnerable/key worker bubble during the week on a different day, they could not attend the bubble in Dolphin Class. Bubbles must be kept separate all week, it is your decision which one you prefer your child to be in.

If the demand in Reception/Year 1 is high then we may need to split this however if the demand is low then we would invite Nursery into this bubble. The final organisation is therefore dependent on numbers. The provision will be reviewed regularly and hopefully as more teaching staff are able to return to working in school, we can increase the provision on offer. Please note siblings can attend different bubbles but must stay in the same bubble all week, again this is your decision.

### Plan B

As above with the addition of inviting Nursery in for one morning or day per week and this is looking likely to be a Wednesday.

\*I will be communicating with Nursery later in the week following feedback from this survey.

### Daily Timetable

There will be regular hand washing intervals including after arriving and before leaving school.
