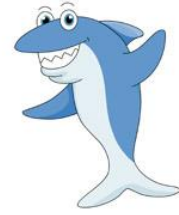




# Shark Class Year 5 & 6

A reminder that all children have a login to TTRS which the school has paid into. I can already see an improvement in the speed that children are able to answer times table and division questions!

### Weekly testing:

Wednesday – Spelling  
Friday – Times tables and Big Maths  
\*Year 5 will continue be tested on 20 spellings and this term whereas Year 6 are focussing all the words from the Year 5/6 list they have been given.

### Water Bottles:

In the interest of personal hygiene, children must bring their own water bottle to school. As the weather is warming up, this is especially important this term.
