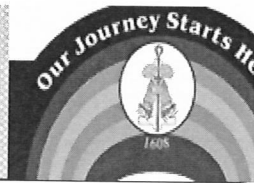




Ireleth St Peter's CE Primary School

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Dear Parents,

On Thursday 6th July, Whale and Shark class have an exciting opportunity to take part in a Swimsafe session at Rayrigg Meadow. Swimsafe is a practical, wild swimming session run by the RNLI which is held in Lake Windermere and is a valuable experience, designed to teach primary age children essential information about swimming safely in open water.

We will be leaving school at 9:40am to ensure that we arrive on time and have time to change and prepare for the session which starts at 11am and lasts around 60 minutes. Following the session, we will change and eat lunch at the site before setting off back to school. We expect to return to school at approximately 1:45pm. Children attending will therefore need a packed lunch, which can be ordered from Mrs Buckingham if required. Throughout the trip the children will be supervised at all times by myself, Miss Ritchie and qualified Swimsafe instructors.

The session is free of charge and we will be using cars to transport children so there is no cost to take part. The children will receive a free badge, bag, t-shirt and swimming cap for participating and all wet suits will be provided. Children need to provide their own towels and swimwear.

In order to take part, children must be able to swim 25m (one length of a standard swimming pool).
